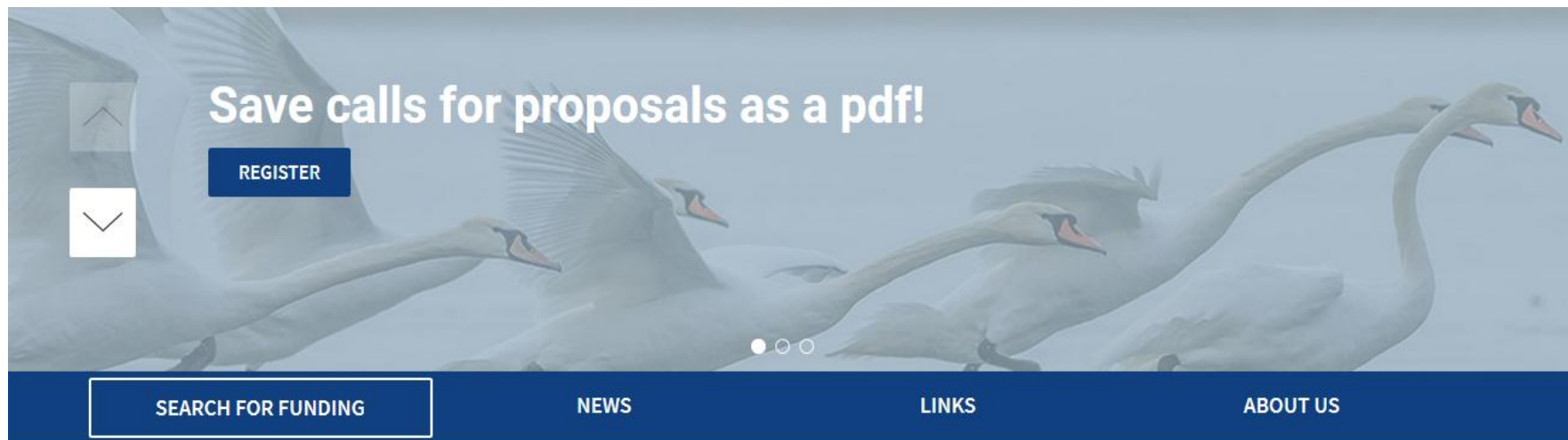

What is EuroAccess?

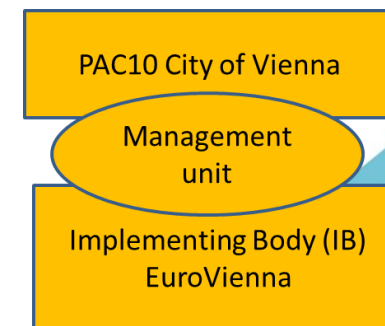
An online search tool which can be used to find potential and available funding possibilities for EU-projects in the Danube Region

Background: EUSDR Action Plan – PA10 action 7: *„to review bottlenecks relating to the low absorption rate of EU funds and to ensure better coordination of funding“*

2 main reasons of the low absorption rate of EU funds in the Danube Region:

- no central information point on EU-funds
- limited knowledge on available EU-funds

➔ **Objective:** to provide a central information point and facilitate access to EU funding

- Filters: applicant, provenance, funding area, thematic focus, keyword search

Description of programme "Horizon 2020"	Horizon 2020 is the biggest EU Research and Innovation programme ever with nearly 80 billion € of funding available over 7 years (2014 to 2020) – in addition to the private investment that this money will attract. It promises more breakthroughs, discoveries and world-firsts by taking great ideas from the lab to the market.

Description of programme "Food Security, Sustainable Agriculture and Forestry, Marine, Maritime and Inland Water Research and the Bioeconomy"	Agriculture, forestry, fisheries and aquaculture, together with the bio-based industries, are integral parts of the European economy and society. Relying on the use of limited natural resources, these sectors produce and process biological resources to satisfy the demand of consumers and a wide range of industries for food, feed, bio-energy and bio-based products. While they enhance Europe's self-reliance and provide jobs and business opportunities essential for rural, coastal and marine areas, these sectors are also facing significant challenges which require solutions based on research and innovation. A transition is needed towards an optimal and renewable use of biological resources and towards sustainable primary production and processing systems. These systems will need to produce more food, fibre and other bio-based products with minimised inputs, environmental impact and greenhouse gas emissions, and with enhanced ecosystem services, zero waste and adequate societal value.
Call	Integrated system innovation in valorising urban biowaste
Description of call "Integrated system innovation in valorising urban biowaste"	Proposals shall focus on an integrated system innovation approach in urban biowaste recycling and valorisation for the production of high-value biobased products, including proteins for food and feed. Proposals shall ensure the full integration of the upgraded urban biowaste value chain into the existing local waste/wastewater management schemes. Proposals shall guarantee the active participation of local and regional authorities, waste/wastewater management utilities, (biobased) industries, the scientific community, local communities and citizens.
