#### **Project description**

Part of the natural, social, cultural and economic heritage of the region, sturgeons are flagship species of the Danube Basin. Although they once supported Danube community residents' livelihood, today they are on the verge of extinction. So, the program Sturgeon 2020 wants to support their preservation through an integrative approach, combining environmental protection with social and economic measures aiming not only to benefit sturgeons, but also to improve the economic situation of local stakeholders (e.g. by stimulating the development of small business, local markets, aquaculture and ecotourism; and reducing illegal fishing).

#### **Project goal**

The project is comprised of six interconnected topics, including key measures such as habitat protection, migration route restoration, supportive stocking programs, economic alternatives to sturgeon fishery, fighting illegal fishing, the caviar black market, and ecological education.
