PA10 topics for SMF

Topic	Explanation
Low-threshold provision of local services for ethnic minorities (e.g. Roma), refugees, people with disabilities, lone parents, migrants, lowskilled people, homeless people, early school leavers and/or elderly people in cities and municipalities.	Cities and municipalities are crucial in the implementation of public services that support sustainable development and social inclusion on a daily basis. Activities aiming at cutting bureaucracy, improving the quality of administrative procedures, facilitate accessibility, as well as improving skills, competences and motivation of civil servants are essential factors to improve the quality of public services that address ethnic minorities (e.g. Roma), refugees, people with disabilities, lone parents, migrants, low-skilled people, homeless people, early school leavers and/or elderly people.
Fostering innovative models of cooperation between civil society and local public authorities to develop modern social and health services.	Projects under this topic should aim at improving the quality of public services and optimising governance mechanisms through innovative models of cooperation between civil society (organisations) and local public institutions. Projects addressing this topic should foster an open dialogue with different authorities and institutions, and a better acknowledgement of civil society expertise and views in public services in order to jointly develop modern social and health services.
To create innovative tools to promote digital cities in the Danube Region in order to strengthen transparency.	The topic addresses projects aiming at the development and implementation of innovative tools that promoting the smart cities approach that entails an integrated strategy involving ICT and resilient development. Furthermore, the projects or studies need to address multi-stakeholder engagement with a special emphasis on cooperation between cities and companies.
Fostering transnational/cross border cooperation at local level to overcome administrative interregional barriers	Establishing structures to facilitate cross-border service provisions such as cross-border fire fighting operations, emergency services, disaster response
