Directions

From the airport

Option A) Taxi: Take a taxi to Trg Marka Marulića, which takes up to 30 minutes (approx. 150 HRK/20 EUR fixed fare).

The taxi stand is located at the international arrival gate at the airport.

Payment is only possible in Croatian Kuna (HRK) with cash. You can withdraw money at several ATMs at the airport building.

For rides in Zagreb and from the city to the airport we recommend the following taxis:

Option B) Public transport:

1) By airport bus: from the airport to the Central Bus Station

From Zagreb Airport "Pleso" to last stop, the Central Bus Station, busses of the national airline "Croatia Airlines" run every half an hour. The bus stop is located at the international arrivals gate. The fare is priced 30 HRK/3,94 EUR. A daily ticket costs 40 HRK/5,26 EUR. The journey lasts approximately 30 minutes.

The following tramlines will take you directly from the Bus Station to the Croatian State Archive: line 2 (direction Črnomerec), get off the tram at the fifth stop, named "Vodnikova".

For the public transport system of Zagreb you can buy one-way tickets (10 HRK/1,32 EUR), daily tickets (30 HRK/3,94 EUR) and three-day tickets (70 HRK/9,21 EUR). Tickets can be purchased from the tram driver (only one-way) and at the newsstands "TISAK" and "INOVINE".

When you arrive at the tram station "Vodnikova" walk back about 100 meters. The State Archive is located at the left side, at the centre of the place. The entrance is at the opposite side.

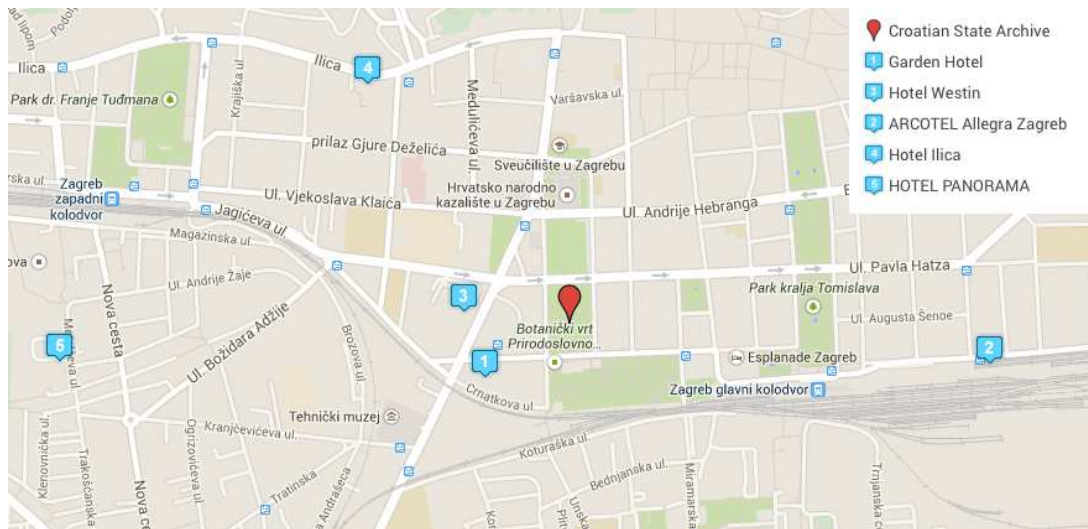
The 4th Danube Financing Dialogue from 23rd to 24th of April 2015 takes place at the Croatian State Archives as indicated in the map below.
