What kind of impact?

If we want to assess the direct and indirect causal contribution of an intervention to change:

What works or does not work, how, for whom, and why?


What can be measured and is it adequate to assess the impact (e.g. publications, patents, altmetrics)?

Can we overcome several problems (causality, attribution, time lag, impact is dynamic not static, impact without traces, lack in evidence)?

Is there a "comparison group"?

What would have happened without the project?





- Inputs: resources directed towards an activity
- Activities: intentional part of the implementation
- Outputs: direct product of the activities
- Outcomes: change target groups' behaviour or level/quality of functioning
- Impact: intended as well as unintended changes that occur in a system (hard to measure and, due to long-term nature, outside the activity (e.g. project) scope)




